OPEN SESSION - Reeve McDonald opened the floor to anyone who wanted to make comments or suggestions regarding municipal issues.

The following questions and concerns were raised by members of the audience:

- Drinking water quality / safety RM water main line in culvert and/or in ditch where drainage water covers the line
- Doctor's cottage needs upgrading; an improved dwelling might help to recruit doctors for the whole summer
- Has RM considered recruiting nurse-practitioners?
- Sunset shoreline erosion protection works required between Arthur & Patricia has RM considered using gabions?
- Some owners north of Arthur were uncertain that the revetment work undertaken south of Arthur would be effective & did not wish to participate without seeing the results
- More signage is required to warn people to stay off the banks
- Beach Warning Sign (no dogs, liquor, fireworks, etc...) required at Yacht Clubhouse beach
- Poor condition of many RM roads too many potholes can RM do something about this?
- David Road condition too many potholes RM should consider returning it to a gravel surface

The above questions / concerns were answered by council. Additional information was provided as follows:

- RM water main lines are under "positive" pressure; it is unlikely that water could flow into them this concern will be discussed with MB Water Stewardship
- RM is presently upgrading the Dr's cottage it will be difficult to recruit doctors regardless of the condition of the residence
- There are not enough Nurse-practitioners from a provincial perspective for the time-being it will be difficult to recruit them
